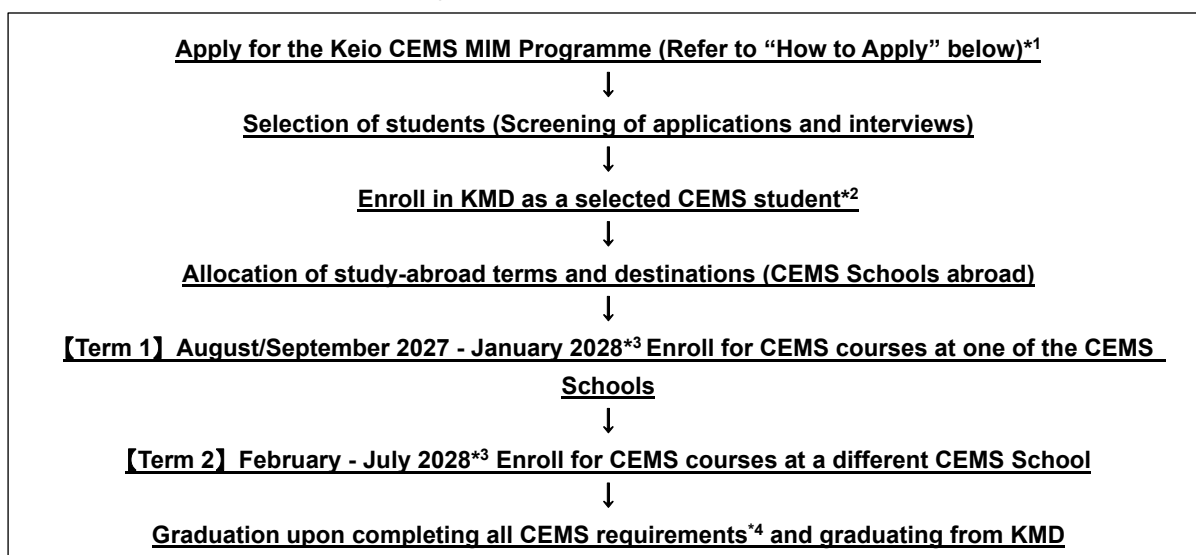

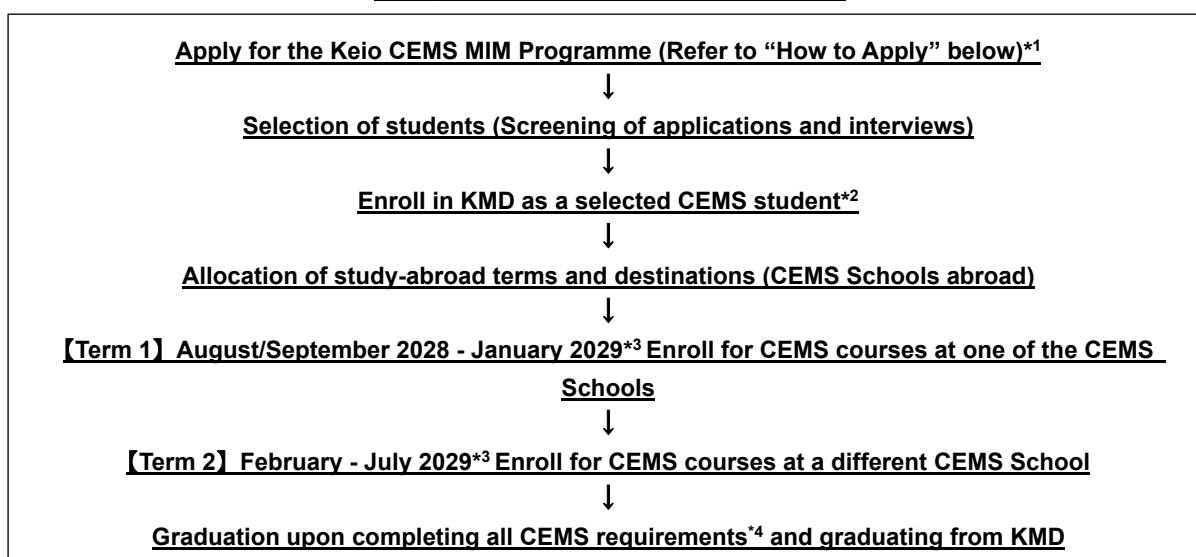
Application Guidebook Keio CEMS Master's in International Management Programme (CEMS MIM Programme) For Enrollment in September 2026, April 2027 or September 2027

Keio University Graduate School of Media Design (KMD) offers a double-degree programme with CEMS, the Global Alliance in Management Education. Since it is a double-degree programme, you will not be able to earn the CEMS MIM degree without also earning a master's degree from KMD. Please note, as shown in the flow chart below, the semesters (Term 1/Term 2) and the universities where you will be allocated for studying abroad will be determined after you are selected as a Keio CEMS MIM student. CEMS is interested in producing graduates who will thrive on the global stage. Therefore, we select students who will enthusiastically exert their utmost effort wherever they are in the world.

*1 You will be able to indicate your preferences regarding your study-abroad terms and destinations when filling out CEMS Web Registration (the CEMS Common Application Form). Based on your preferences, your study abroad terms and destinations will be determined by the CEMS Steering Committee after the final interview. However, there is no guarantee that you will be allocated to your preferred terms and destinations. You are not permitted to change your preferences after the application deadline.

*2 Students are required to pay a Student Registration and Handling Fee (€110 for students in AY 2026/2027) to the CEMS headquarters. As a general rule, students of the CEMS MIM Programme are exempt from tuition fees at their study abroad destinations (certain institutions may charge students with additional fees for specific programs, such as Block Seminars). CEMS students should bear the costs of their flight tickets and living expenses (e.g., accommodation, food, transportation, and other expenses).

*3 Term dates and schedules vary by CEMS School.

*4 The CEMS Graduation Ceremony will take place once a year in November/December at one of the CEMS Schools.

Application Requirements

Applicants must meet all the conditions listed below:

<p>1. Eligibility</p>	<p>Applicants are required to fulfill at least one of the following criteria. Please note that a preliminary entrance qualification review will be necessary for applicants qualifying for admission under criterion 2 or 7 below.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Graduated or expects to graduate from a university in Japan 2. Spent three years or more at a university (or the equivalent) in Japan by the time of enrollment in the master's program and has achieved or is expected to achieve outstanding academic results as acknowledged by KMD 3. Earned or expects to earn a bachelor's degree from the National Institution for Academic Degrees and Quality Enhancement of Higher Education of Japan 4. Completed or expects to complete 16 years of schooling outside Japan 5. Designated by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology of Japan (refer to MEXT Notice No. 5 of Showa 28) 6. Awarded or expects to be awarded a degree equivalent to or higher than a bachelor's degree for the completion of a course requiring three years or more at an overseas university, etc. 7. Acknowledged by KMD to have academic skills equivalent to those of university graduates and is at least 22 years of age at the time of admission
<p>2. Language Proficiency</p>	<p>Applicants must be competent in English at the time of application. Applicants should be aware of the CEMS language requirements upon graduation before applying for the CEMS MIM Programme. Please refer to the "Language Requirements upon Graduation" section in the "Keio CEMS MIM Programme Application Guidelines for Keio Outgoing Students" for more details, which you can refer at the website below.</p> <p>https://www.ic.keio.ac.jp/en/study/cemsmim/outbound_apply.html</p> <p>You must provide proof of English proficiency (if English is not your mother tongue) through any of the following (minimum level):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - TOEFL iBT <p>Test taken before January 21, 2026: overall score 100 (0-120 scale)</p> <p>Tests taken on or after January 21, 2026: overall score 5.0 (1-6 scale), including a reference to a minimum score of 100 on the old scoring scale</p>

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - IELTS (Academic) : 7.0 - CPE: C - CAE: B - BEC: Higher B - Pearson Test of English Academic (PTE): 68- Passing one of the CEMS-accredited English exams - A-level GCSE issued in Singapore - Acquisition of one of the following degrees: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (1) A bachelor's degree entirely taught in English from an institution located in an English-speaking country, or from a CEMS or an EQUIS/AACSB accredited institution (2) A bachelor's degree from the PEARL Programme offered by the Faculty of Economics, Keio University <p><u>*You are required to submit the proof of English proficiency along with all the other application documents.</u></p>
3. Academic Preparation	<p>You must meet one of the following two conditions to demonstrate your academic preparedness for the CEMS MIM Programme at the time of your application:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. You have received a bachelor's degree in either management, economics, or a related field; or 2. You have successfully passed the equivalent of a minimum of 60 ECTS credits from a full-time business education (to be presented at the start of the programme). <p>Note: If you have not received a bachelor's diploma in Management, Economics, or any related fields, nor earned the equivalent of a minimum of 60 ECTS credits from a full-time business programme (and are prepared to submit relevant documentation at the start of the programme), you are required to submit a personal statement that describes your background (both educational and work experience) to demonstrate that you satisfy the above conditions.</p>

How to Apply

After you have thoroughly read the Application Requirements section above, you must:

- (1) Complete registration to KMD Web Entry System,
- (2) Submit all the application documents, as given in the Application Materials section below. The documents must be in the same order as listed below.

Application Materials (All documents must be written in English)

Please submit all the documents in English. In addition to the documents listed in “3.5. Application Documents” in the “KMD Application Guidebook (Master’s Program)”, please submit the following CEMS application documents. You are required to upload the data for all of your application documents to the Web Entry System. You also need to send the originals for the specified application documents separately by post. For details on how to submit the application documents, please refer to “6. Submission of Applications” section in the “KMD Application Guidebook (Master’s Program)”.

Make sure to enter your examinee number in the top right for all of your application documents.

You may declare more than one mother tongue. If you wish to declare more than one, fill in a declaration for each language.</p>

Language Proficiency Certificate (<u>Original Certificate required</u>)	D	<u>Required</u>	<p>If English is not your mother tongue, submit an original certificate of the relevant English language proficiency certificate listed in “2. Language Proficiency” in the Application Requirements section above. You should also note the following rules:</p> <p>※If you have not received a hard copy of your test certificate, but the score is available online, you may submit a printout of the relevant webpage at the time of your application. Submit the original certificate after you receive it.</p>

			<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● For TOEFL Test scores, submit the “Test Taker Score Report”; for IELTS Test scores, submit the “Test Report Form (Academic Module).” ● TOEFL ITP (Institutional Testing Program) scores are not acceptable. ● “TOEFL My Best Scores” and “IELTS Academic One Skill Retake” are not accepted. ● TOEFL iBT Home Edition Test: a minimum score of 100 with a score of at least 20 in each section for the older version, an overall score of 5.0 for the updated version is required in the Internet-based TOEFL (iBT). ● IELTS Online Test: a minimum score of 7.0. ● The test must have been taken within 2 years prior to the final deadline of the application.

7. Transcript (<u>Original document in English required</u>)	A	Required	Submit your undergraduate transcript in English. Applicants who have graduated (or are expected to graduate) from more than one university and/or graduate school must submit transcripts from each institution or university.
8. Written Oath	D	Not required	Sign and submit the Written Oath, which is available via the following URL: https://drive.google.com/drive/folders/1LJZszfcc9mVV1FRfB1tEAHeBliMmz4Ew?usp=sharing
9. Statement of your background	D	Not required	A statement that describes your background (both educational and work experience) to satisfy the conditions described in “Academic Preparation” in Application Requirements above. (A4-size PDF, one page)
